Manual Daily Test

- First inspect the defibrillator for signs of damage.
- It is not necessary to switch the AED on for the daily test!
- Observe the display to the top right side of the AED, and perform the following checks.
- 1. The 'OK' symbol is visible.
- The battery and service indicator shows more than one bar, and does not show empty (no bars) or a spanner symbol.
- Check that there is one pack of in date 'Quik-Combo' pads preconnected to the AED, and that the pack of pads is sealed and in date.
- 4. There should be one additional set of adult Quik-Combo pads.
